

About the artist:

Brett WHITELEY's love of art began at an early age, nurtured by study and travel. He is now considered to be one of Australia's greatest painters. This work of art is arguably the Gallery's most loved painting. WHITELEY was commissioned to produce this work by Newcastle resident collector Dr William Bowmore in 1977. Radiating with the heat of an Australia summer, this passive painting combines all of WHITELEY's stylistic trademarks and influences.

Create:

Imagine you are sitting on one of the rocks along the bend of the river in Summer at Carcoar. Make a drawing of your view from the rock. What will your view include? Will you sketch curved lines of a road, a weeping willow tree, a Xanthorrhoea (grass tree), a magpie, or how about the title of the work hidden in the painting.
